

## 1674 Rental of Maclean of Duart Estates in Mull, Coll, Jura, Morvern & Tiree

### **Background note**

*The Earl of Argyll, who had bought up the debts of Maclean of Duart, gained legal ownership of his estates in 1674 through the aid of his patron, the powerful Duke of Lauderdale. To facilitate this takeover he obtained Letters of Ejection of Duart's tenants. When the Macleans resisted, Argyll was issued a Commission of Fire and Sword by the government and invaded Mull. The Campbells, aided by a small number of government troops, captured the infant Maclean chief, Sir John Maclean, and forced the surrender of Duart Castle.*

*Lachlan Maclean of Brolas, the tutor or guardian of Sir John, entered into an agreement with representatives of the Earl of Argyll at Moy on Mull in September of 1674, in which the rents of the Duart Estate were surrendered to the Earl of Argyll.*

***This document listed the tenants of the Duart Estate, who, it is important to note, were the tacksmen, and not the actual occupiers, or sub-tenants, farming the various properties shown. The tenants of the Duart Estate, 1674, was listed in Highland Papers, Volume I, edited by J.N.R. MacPhail, which was published by the Scottish Historical Society in 1914.***

*The events of 1674 were not the end of the Maclean resistance to the takeover of the Duart Estate by the Campbells. Physical possession of Tiree by the Campbells did not actually take place until 1692*
